Dear Joe Silveira:

As you are aware, the Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“FPPC”) received a referral from the FPPC’s Statements of Economic Interests (“SEI”) Unit regarding your failure to timely file a Leaving Office Statement of Economic Interests (“SEI”) as a Board Member with the Schools Insurance Group Northern Alliance I. However, the Enforcement Division found that you left that position on July 14, 2021.

Because it does not appear that you received any notifications from the FPPC’s SEI Unit pertaining to your Leaving Office SEI, and the notifications regarding your Leaving Office SEI were sent to your former agency’s email address after you left office, the Enforcement Division contacted you regarding the requirement to file a Leaving Office SEI. Immediately after you received the notification, you responded and filed your Leaving Office SEI. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.
