As you are aware, the Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“FPPC”) received a referral from the County of Santa Barbara regarding your failure to timely file your Leaving Office Statement of Economic Interests (“SEI”) for your position as a Supervising Planner with Planning & Development.
