The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").¹ This letter is in response to a complaint alleging your client, Brett Pedroia, made contributions over-the-limit to a local candidate-controlled committee, Cynthia Rodriguez for Yolo County District Attorney 2022 (the "Committee"). After conducting our review of the case, we are closing this matter without further action.

Your client did not make contributions over-the-limit to the Committee. Therefore, the allegation has been disproven.
