No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2022-00810, Fauzia Rizvi; Fauzia Rizvi for Assembly 2022

Dear Fauzia Rivzi,

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“FPPC”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a sworn complaint alleging you and your committee, *Fauzia Rizvi for Assembly 2022*, accepted two contributions that exceeded the \$4,900 limit from a single source per election. Additionally, the complaint alleged that you failed to timely disclose certain economic interests on your Candidate Statement of Economic Interest (“SEI”).

The Enforcement Division found that you disclosed two contributions received of \$9,800 on the semi-annual campaign statement for the period covering May 22, 2022 through June 30, 2022. However, you filed an amendment to the semi-annual statement on October 27, 2022, before the complaint was filed with the Enforcement Division, to clarify that the contributions received of \$9,800 were attributed to both the June 7, 2022 Primary Election and the November 8, 2022 General Election (\$4,900 per election). The Enforcement Division also found that, at the time you filed your Candidate SEI, you did not have economic interests that were required to be disclosed on your Candidate SEI.
