The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").¹ This letter is in response to a sworn complaint alleging you created a newspaper, The Scoop, and failed to file applicable campaign statements associated with the production of the newspaper. After conducting our investigation and review of the case, we are closing this matter without further action.

The Enforcement Division's investigation could not determine who was responsible for producing the newspaper at issue here. Therefore, we are closing this matter without further action as there is insufficient evidence to support a finding that you violated the Act.
