**RE: Closure Letter: FPPC Case No. 18/684; In the Matter of Sarah Lovick**

Dear Paul Minney:

The Enforcement Division of the California Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).<sup>1</sup> This letter is in response to our investigation concerning a sworn complaint in connection with the above referenced complaint alleging your client violated the conflict of interest provisions of the Act. More specifically, the complaint stated that your client had a financial interest in Achieve 3000 when voting as a Clayton Valley Governing Board Member on June 13, 2018, to approve account licenses for Achieve 3000.

After a full investigation, the Enforcement Division found that Lovick did not have a financial interest in Achieve 3000. As such, the allegations have been disproven.
