The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").¹ This letter is in response to a referral that you failed to file the pre-election campaign statements in the November 2022 election. The Enforcement Division has decided to close its file on this matter without prosecution.

The Enforcement Division obtained evidence that you filed a Short Form 470. No additional evidence was found that you qualified as a committee with additional filing requirements. As such, the allegations have been disproven. Therefore, we are closing this matter with this No Action Closure Letter.
