RE: No Action Closure Letter: Unknown Text Messages; FPPC No. 2020-01049

Dear Desiree Myers,

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a sworn complaint you made regarding certain mailings, allegedly created by “PVRG” and “Moms for Sandy Davidson,” distributed in connection with the November 6, 2020 General Election. After investigation and review of the case, the investigation was unable to determine who was responsible for the mailings. Therefore, there is insufficient evidence to support a finding there was a violation of the Act.

Based on the foregoing, and in accordance with the Enforcement Division Policy Directives formally adopted by the Commission on January 26, 2023, which requires the Enforcement Division to take all appropriate actions within their discretion to decrease the Division’s annual carryover caseload, the Enforcement Division is closing this case without further action.² Discretion was used based upon mitigating or aggravating circumstances and the totality of the circumstances.³ This resolution may not be used as a comparable case for other enforcement matters.⁴
