No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2023-00116, Steve Danley

Dear Mr. Danley:

As you are aware, the Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“FPPC”) received a referral from the FPPC’s Statements of Economic Interests (“SEI”) Unit regarding your failure to timely file your Leaving Office SEI for your position as Acting City Manager for the City of Fullerton.

Because it appeared that the notifications sent to you from the SEI Unit pertaining to your Leaving Office SEI were sent to your agency email address after you left the position, the Enforcement Division contacted you regarding the requirement to file a Leaving Office SEI. Immediately after you received the notification, you responded and filed your Leaving Office SEI. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action. Although the Enforcement Division is closing this matter without seeking a penalty, you are still required to pay any late filing fees assessed by your filing officer, the FPPC’s SEI Unit.
