**Re: No Action Closure Letter - In the Matter of Hanford Now and Dan Chin,
FPPC No. 2016-0711**

To Whom It May Concern:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").¹ This matter arose as a commission-initiated complaint, as violations were found during an investigation of a related matter. On September 26, 2022, the Enforcement Division issued an Amended Accusation. The complaint described violations of the Act such as accepting cash contributions in values of \$100 or more and failure to timely file campaign statements. The Enforcement Division is closing this case without further action because Dan Chin, the treasurer and principal officer for the Committee, Hanford Now, has passed away.
