No Action Closure Letter: FPPC No. 2023-00298; George Morrow

Dear George Morrow:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“FPPC”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ As you are aware, the Enforcement Division received a referral from the FPPC’s Statements of Economic Interests (“SEI”) Unit regarding your failure to timely file a Leaving Office SEI for your position as an Alternate Commissioner with the Transmission Agency of Northern California.
