**No Action Closure Letter Re: FPPC No. 2019-00540; Yes on A for Affordable Housing, A
Coalition of Home Builders, Healthcare Providers, Community Foundations, et al.; Chris
Wilder**

Dear Chris Wilder and Committee:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This communication pertains to a Commission-initiated investigation, regarding Yes on A for Affordable Housing, A Coalition of Home Builders, Healthcare Providers, Community Foundations, et al.’s (the “Committee”) potential violations of the campaign disclosure and advertisement disclaimer provisions of the Act.

The investigation in this matter found that a sign advertisement paid for by the Committee failed to include the required disclaimers. However, the advertisement did include the language “Yes on A Affordable Housing” and the Committee’s website and social media web addresses, so there was some indication of who was responsible for the advertisement.

Further, the Act’s statute of limitations to pursue administrative prosecution is five years, and the violations are beyond that timeframe. (Section 91000.5.) Therefore, the Enforcement Division is closing this matter without further action.
