Dear Mr. Phan:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act.¹ This matter arises from a Commission-initiated investigation with respect to certain contributions that were made on or about November 23 and December 15, 2016 to your committee, Neighbors for Anthony Phan 2016 – City Council.

The purpose of the investigation was to determine whether or not proper information was reported with respect to the true source of the campaign contributions. We have completed our investigation, and we found insufficient evidence to support a finding that the Act was violated. This finding only applies to Case No. 2019-00917 and does not apply to any other open Enforcement cases against you and Neighbors for Anthony Phan 2016 – City Council.
