Dear John Wiersma:

The Enforcement Division of the California Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a sworn complaint regarding failing to properly disclose financial interests on your 2018 through 2020 Statements of Economic Interests (“SEI”) in your capacity as the General Manager of the Henry Miller Reclamation District (“HMRD”).

The Enforcement Division investigation did not find evidence that you failed to properly disclose financial interests on your SEIs. There is insufficient evidence that there was a violation of the Act. As such, the Enforcement Division has decided to close this matter without further action.
