No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2022-00625; Mountain View Thrive, Alejandro Nunez

Dear Committee and Alejandro Nunez:

The Fair Political Practice Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”)¹. As you are aware, the Enforcement Division received a referral from the City of Mountain View regarding your failure to timely file campaign statements Semi-Annual Form 460s.

Upon reviewing the campaign statements filed before the referral, it appears that you did not qualify as a “committee” and therefore, you did not trigger the requirement to file campaign statements. A “committee” is a person or combination of persons who receives contributions totaling \$2,000 or more in a calendar year.² According to your campaign statements, you did not reach the \$2,000 threshold. For this reason, we are closing this case without further action.
