To Whom It May Concern,

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in regard to a commission-initiated enforcement matter against the committee, Yes on B – A Coalition of Labor, Renters, and Environmentalists for Responsible Public Banking, now re-designated as People for Public Banking (ID No. 1412690). The Commission received information that the committee was responsible for a flyer that did not include the correct advertisement disclosure. However, after an investigation, the Enforcement Division has determined that this flyer was created in July 2018 by a volunteer who printed approximately 100 copies from a home printer to hand out at a meeting. Based on this, the Enforcement Division is closing this matter with this letter.
