**No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2020-00969; San Diego County

Dear San Diego County Assessor/Recorder/Clerk:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").¹ This letter is in response to a sworn complaint against the San Diego County Assessor/Recorder/Clerk, alleging violations of the campaign disclosure and advertisement disclaimer provisions of the Act.

After our investigation, the Enforcement Division found that the activities alleged in the complaint fall within the exceptions under Regulation 18420.1, subdivision (e)(2) and/or (4). Therefore, we are closing this matter without further action as the allegations have been disproven.
