No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2020-00845; Schlossman, Wong, Matthew, Johnson

Dear All:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a sworn complaint alleging that you violated the campaign disclosure provisions and advertisement disclaimer provisions of the Act. After our investigation and review of the case, the Enforcement Division has found that you did not qualify as a committee under the Act and no campaign disclosure and/or advertisement disclaimers were required. Therefore, we are closing this matter without further action because the allegations have been disproven.
