The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").¹ This letter is in response to a sworn complaint that you made regarding yard signs without advertisement disclosures concerning the campaign Rex Richardson for Mayor 2022. After concluding our investigation and review of the case, we are closing this matter. The investigation was unable to determine who was responsible for the yard signs. Therefore, there is insufficient evidence to support a finding that there was a violation of the Act.
