No Action Closure Letter Re: FPPC No. 2022-00776; Unknown Payor – Yard Signs No on Measure A

Dear Don Shoffstall:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to your complaint that alleged someone failed to properly report and include the proper disclosures on a yard sign opposing Measure A in La Quinta. After conducting our investigation and review of the case, the Enforcement Division was unable to confirm the identity of the party responsible for the advertisement. Therefore, we are closing this matter without further action.
