The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").¹ This letter is in response to a sworn complaint alleging Gutierrez for City Council 2020 (ID# 1426446) (the "Committee") failed to timely file 24-hour reports related to advertisements produced by the Mountain View Professional Firefighters Political Action Committee (ID# 1229347).

After conducting our investigation and review into the matter, we are closing this case without further action as the allegations will be resolved in FPPC Case No. 2022-00462.
