No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2022-00697; Scott Tonnesen

Dear Scott Tonnesen:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to an anonymous complaint alleging that you failed to disclose economic interests on your Statements of Economic Interests (“SEIs”) for your position as a Loan Officer Assistant for Citizens Financial.

PREP Course Completion

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (PREP) course regarding SEIs. In addition, you have amended your SEIs to disclose those economic interests. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.
