No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2022-00827; Unknown Sender - Letter re The Truth about the Tripoli Mailer

Dear Linda Tripoli:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").¹ This letter is in response to a sworn complaint that alleged a campaign mailer was sent opposing your candidacy without the proper advertisement disclaimers. After our investigation and review of the case, we are closing this matter without further action. The investigation was unable to determine who was responsible for the mailer, and therefore, there is insufficient evidence to support a finding there was a violation of the Act.
