No Action Closure Letter: FPPC No. 2021-00514; David Pruitt

Dear David Pruitt:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“FPPC”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a sworn complaint regarding failing to report stock interests on your 2018 through 2020 Statement of Economic Interests (“SEI”) in your capacity as a member of the Board of Trustees of the Henry Miller Reclamation District (“HMRD”). After conducting review of this case, we are closing this matter without further action.

The Enforcement Division’s investigation confirmed that you complied with the disclosure requirements of the Act. As such, the allegations have been disproven.
