No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC Case No. 2020-00375; No on C – Santa Clarans for Voting Rights Committee, a Coalition of Community and Civic Organizations and Individuals, Sponsored by John Edward (Jed) York and Affiliated Entities, including the Forty Niners Football Company LLC

Dear Rebecca J. Olson:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a Commission-initiated investigation into the above-referenced committee involving the disclosure of polling results received from its sponsor.

The Committee disclosed the receipt of the polling results at issue here on its pre-election campaign statement for the reporting period ending February 15, 2020, timely filed on February 20, 2020. After conducting our investigation and review of the case, the Enforcement Division determined that the Committee timely disclosed the receipt of the polling results. Thus, the allegations have been disproven and the Enforcement Division is closing this matter without further action.
