No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2024-00134; Scott Smith

Dear Scott Smith:

As you are aware, the Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“FPPC”) received a referral from the Commission’s Statement of Economic Interests (“SEI”) Unit regarding your failure to timely file your 2022 Annual SEI for your position as a Board Member with the Housing Workers’ Compensation Authority. However, the Enforcement Division found that you left that position in December 2022.

Because it does not appear that you received any notifications from the Commission’s SEI Unit pertaining to your Leaving Office SEI, and the notifications regarding your 2022 Annual SEI were sent to your former agency’s email address after you left office, the Enforcement Division contacted you regarding the requirement to file a Leaving Office SEI. Immediately after you received the notification, you responded and filed your Leaving Office SEI. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.
