No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2024-00263; Stuart Gilchrist

Dear Stuart Gilchrist:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to referrals from the Commission’s Statement of Economic Interests (“SEI”) Unit. The Commission’s SEI Unit indicated that you failed to timely file your Assuming Office SEI for your position as an Alternate Board Member with the Regional Waste Management Authority. Additionally, the Commission’s SEI Unit indicated that you failed to timely file your 2022 Annual SEI for your positions as a City Council Member with the City of Marysville, Board Member for the Feather River Air Quality Management District, and Board Member for the Yuba Sutter Economic Development Corporation.

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (PREP) course regarding SEIs. In addition, you have filed the missing SEIs. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action. Although the Enforcement Division is closing this matter without seeking a penalty, you are still required to pay any late filing fees assessed by your filing officer, the Commission’s SEI Unit.
