No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2022-00965; Szu Pei Lu Yang for Rowland Water District Board of Directors District 5 2026

Dear Committee and Szu Pei Lu Yang,

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act¹ (the “Act”). This letter is in response to a referral from the Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk’s office alleging that your 2013 committee, *Szu Pei Lu Yang for Rowland Water District Board of Directors District 5 2013*, failed to file a Form 410 (Statement of Organization) Amendment to change the year in your committee’s name from 2013 to 2022.

However, we have since learned that the matter was referred in error as you were not a candidate on a ballot in 2022. You will be a candidate in 2026 and you have filed a Form 410 Amendment to reflect this. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.
