The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“FPPC”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a referral from the California Department of Food and Agriculture (“CDFA”) regarding your failure to timely file a 2022 Annual Statement of Economic Interests (“SEI”).

The Enforcement Division found that you filed the missing statement on June 18, 2023, before you were contacted by the Enforcement Division.
