No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2021-00193, Pacificside, Inc. DBA Santa Monica Motel

Dear Pacificside, Inc.:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission ("Commission") enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").¹ This letter is in response to a Commission-initiated investigation into Pacificside, Inc. and whether they had failed to file a Major Donor Campaign Statement.

The Enforcement Division has completed its review and determined that the owner of Pacificside, Inc. had aggregated and disclosed the contribution on their timely filed Major Donor Campaign Statement. Therefore, Pacificside, Inc. was not required to file a Major Donor Campaign Statement. Since this allegation has been disproven, we are closing this matter without further action.
