FPPC Case No. 2021/00999; In the Matter of Democratic Luncheon Club of San Bernardino, Ladd Seekins and Timothy Prince

Dear Democratic Luncheon Club of San Bernardino, Ladd Seekins and Timothy Prince:

As you may know, the Enforcement Division of the California Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to our investigation concerning an anonymous complaint in connection with the above referenced case, alleging the Democratic Luncheon Club of San Bernardino (“Committee”) violated the campaign reporting provisions of the Act. The Enforcement Division is closing its file on this matter with this No Action Closure Letter.

The Enforcement Division determined that the Committee was administratively terminated in 2015 and was successfully re-opened with approval of the Commission’s Executive Director in 2021. During the time the Committee was administratively terminated, the Committee failed to report the proper financial activity for the Semi-Annual campaign statement for the reporting period July 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019. The Committee has now amended this campaign statement. As such, the Enforcement Division is closing our case in this matter without further action.
