No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC Case No. 2021-00935; Stacy Rhoades

Dear Mayor Rhoades:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act.¹ This case arises from an anonymous complaint, which we opened to investigate an alleged conflict of interest—in your capacity as then-Vice Mayor of the City of Ione—regarding a change order (in January 2020) for the North Seco sewer line project plan.

Our investigation to date has revealed insufficient evidence to support a finding that you violated the Act. At this time, we are closing this case without further action. Thank you for your attention to this matter. Do not hesitate to call if you have any questions.
