The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").¹ This letter is in response to a sworn complaint you made regarding certain mail pieces sent out concerning your 2020 candidacy. After concluding our investigation and review of the case, we are closing this matter. The investigation was unable to determine who was responsible for the mail pieces. Therefore, there is insufficient evidence to support a finding that there was a violation of the Act.
