To Whom It May Concern,

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to several complaints received through the Enforcement Division’s AdWatch program regarding anonymous text messages opposing the candidacy of Sharon Melinda Kwan during the November 3, 2022 General Election. We are closing this matter. The investigation was unable to determine who was responsible for the text messages. Therefore, there is insufficient evidence to support a finding there was a violation of the Act.
