Dear Judith Hinh:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a referral from the State of California Housing and Community Development Department regarding your failure to timely file your Assuming Office SEI and Leaving Office SEI for your position as a Housing and Community Development Representative II with the State of California Department of Housing and Community Development.

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (PREP) course regarding SEIs. In addition, you have filed the missing SEIs. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action. Although the Enforcement Division is closing this matter without seeking a penalty, you are still required to pay any late filing fees assessed by your filing officer who can be contacted at HCD.Form700Administration@hcd.ca.gov.
