No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2024-00764; Brad Johnson

Dear Brad Johnson:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to referrals from the County of San Diego alleging that you failed to timely file your Assuming Office, 2021 Annual, and Leaving Office Statements of Economic Interests (“SEIs”). Specifically, the County alleged that you failed to timely file your Assuming Office and 2021 Annual SEIs for the Dehesa School District, and your 2021 Annual and Leaving Office SEIs for the Rancho Santa Fe School District

The Enforcement Division found that you filed your 2021 Annual SEI for your position as Superintendent of Schools with the Dehesa School District before you were contacted by the Enforcement Division. Additionally, the Dehesa School District has since confirmed that you did not hold the Business Manager position; therefore, the Assuming Office and 2021 Annual SEIs for this position are not required. Finally, it appears that you left your position with the Rancho Santa Fe School District in January 2020. Therefore, the 2021 Annual SEI is not required for the Director of Finance position.
