No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2024-00420, Denise Miller for City Council 2024 and Denise Miller

Dear Respondents:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to an anonymous complaint alleging that the committee, Denise Miller for City Council 2024 (the “Committee”), failed to timely file certain campaign statements.

The Enforcement Division has completed its review and determined that the Committee filed various campaign statements that were date stamped after the deadline. However, the City Clerk confirmed that, while they were date stamped after the deadline, the date stamp did not necessarily indicate the date of filing. As a result, there is insufficient evidence to support a finding that you violated the Act, and we are closing this matter without further action.
