Dear Julia Sierk,

As you are aware, the Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“FPPC”) received a referral from the Commission’s Statement of Economic Interests (“SEIs”) Unit regarding your failure to timely file your Assuming Office, 2021 Annual, and 2022 Annual SEIs as a City Council Member with the City of Sutter Creek,

After receiving a phone call from the Enforcement Division regarding the requirement to file your SEIs, you immediately filed the missing SEIs. You explained that you had not received any written notifications regarding the missing SEIs. We have since learned that the notifications were sent an email address you no longer use. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action. Although the Enforcement Division is closing this matter without seeking a penalty, you are still required to pay any late filing fees assessed by your filing officer, the Commission’s SEI Unit.
