No Action Closure Letter Re: FPPC No. 2021-00948; No Way Greenway - Vote No on Deceptive Measure D, FORT, Matt Ferrell

Dear Matt Ferrell:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").¹ This letter is in response to a referral that alleged you failed to include proper disclosures on yard sign, text message, and email advertisements. After conducting our investigation and review of the case, the Enforcement Division was unable to confirm who was responsible for the yard signs and when the emails were sent, thus there is insufficient evidence to prove a violation of the Act for these advertisements. Furthermore, the Enforcement Division confirmed that the text messages were sent by volunteers and advertisement disclosure was included, thus this allegation has been disproven. Therefore, we are closing this matter without further action.
