No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2024-00779; Samuel Felix

Dear Samuel Felix:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a referral from the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (“CDCR”) alleging that you failed to timely file your 2023 Annual Statement of Economic Interests (“SEI”) for your position as a Supervisor of Building Trades for CDCR.

The FPPC’s Political Reform Education Program (“PREP”) staff contacted you regarding your failure to file your 2023 Annual SEI. You responded to PREP staff to explain that you did not have access to the email address where CDCR sent notifications. Additionally, you have since filed the 2023 Annual SEI.
