Re: No Action Closure Letter - FPPC Case No. 2023-00324 – In the Matter of San Francisco Bicycle Coalition Education Fund

Dear San Francisco Bicycle Coalition Education Fund:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ As you know, the Fair Political Practices Commission received a sworn complaint against the San Francisco Bicycle Coalition Education Fund alleging, in part, that the group had failed to register as a political committee by filing a statement of organization with the Secretary of State and failed to timely file campaign statements. The complaint was also filed with the San Francisco Ethics Commission.

On August 18, 2023, the San Francisco Ethics Commission executed a Decision and Order with the San Francisco Bicycle Coalition, the San Francisco Bicycle Coalition Education Fund, Brian Wiedenmeier, and Janice Li (SFEC Case No. 1920-075). The decision held, in part, that San Francisco Bicycle Coalition Education Fund had agreed to a single count of violating local ethics provisions and state law by failing to register as a political committee and failing to timely file a pre-election statement in connection with the November 8, 2022 General Election. The total penalty was \$1,000.

As the allegations made in the complaint received by the Enforcement Division have been addressed in another forum, the Enforcement Division is closing this matter with no further action.
