No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2020-00854; Otheree Christian for Trustee 2020, Otheree Christian, George Brown

Dear Committee, Candidate, and Treasurer:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a referral from the Contra Costa County Elections department indicating that you failed to timely file campaign statements for your committee, Otheree Christian for Trustee 2020 (“Committee”).

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (PREP) campaign course for local candidates and candidate-controlled committees. In addition, you have filed the missing campaign statements. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.

Moreover, completion of PREP exempts you from paying late filing fees for the violations listed in the PREP Agreement, i.e., failure to timely file semi-annual campaign statements, a pre-election campaign statement, 24-Hour Contribution reports, a Candidate Intention Statement, and Statement of Organization Amendments, pursuant to Sections 84200, 84200.5, 84203, 85200, 84101, and 84103, respectively.
