No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2024-00309; Rebecca Eisenberg

Dear Rebecca Eisenberg:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to an anonymous complaint alleging that you failed to timely file your Assuming Office Statement of Economic Interests (“SEI”) for your position as a Director for the Santa Clara Valley Water District.

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (“PREP”) course regarding SEIs. In addition, you filed your Assuming Office SEI. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.
