No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2020-01088; Unknown Respondent – Mailers in Opposition to Eric Ching, Candidate for Walnut City Council

Dear Citizens to Protect Walnut Safety:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a sworn complaint alleging that Citizens to Protect Walnut Safety (“the Committee”) violated the advertisement disclaimer and campaign filing provisions of the Act. After our investigation of the case, the Enforcement Division has found that there is insufficient evidence to support a finding that there was a violation of the Act; the investigation was unable to determine who was responsible for the production and distribution of the advertisements at issue. Therefore, we are closing this matter without further action.
