No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2021-00331; Red White and Blueprint LLC

Dear Red White and Blueprint, LLC:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").¹ This letter is in response to a sworn complaint regarding the 2022 Recall Election for Shasta County Board of Supervisors alleging violations of campaign disclosure requirements and advertising disclaimer provisions. After our investigation and review of the case, the Enforcement Division has found insufficient evidence to support that Red, White, and Blueprint LLC qualified as a committee and violated the Act. Therefore, we are closing this matter without further action.
