**No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2024-00593; Dan Quirk**

Dear Dan Quirk:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“FPPC”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).<sup>1</sup> This letter is in response to referrals from the County of San Diego regarding your failure to timely file a 2021 Annual Statement of Economic Interests (“SEI”) for your positions as a Board Member for the San Diego Area Wastewater Management District and the Metro Wastewater Joint Powers Authority.

The Enforcement Division found that you filed the missing statement on March 21, 2023, before you were contacted by the Enforcement Division. For this reason, we are closing this matter without further action.
