The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a referral from the City of Brawley indicating that you failed to timely file your 2022 and 2023 Annual Statements of Economic Interests (“SEI”) for your position as a Planning Commissioner for the City of Brawley.

The Enforcement Division has conducted a review of the matter and found that there is insufficient evidence of violations at this time. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.
