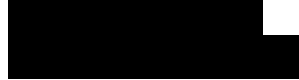

RE: No Action Closure Letter; In the Matter of Cecil Leonard Murray; FPPC No. 2019-01088.

Dear Rev. Cecil Leonard Murray:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a Filing Officer referral alleging that Rev. Cecil Leonard Murray violated the Act’s Statement of Economic Interest (“SEI”) provisions by failing to timely file a 2018 Annual SEI by April 1, 2019; a 2019 Annual SEI by June 1, 2020; a 2020 Annual SEI by April 1, 2021; a 2021 Annual SEI by April 1, 2022; and a 2022 Annual SEI by April 3, 2023. After our investigation of the case, the Enforcement Division has obtained information that Rev. Cecil Leonard Murray is deceased. Therefore, we are closing this matter without further action.
