No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2024-00448; Christopher Collins

Dear Cyndi Glaser:

This letter is in response to the above-referenced referral from your office regarding the individual's failure to timely file their 2022 Annual Statements of Economic Interests ("SEI") for their position as an Alternate Board Member for the Bay Area Regional Interoperable Communications System Authority ("BayRICS"). The Enforcement Division found that the above-named individual left the position for which they were referred. We sent multiple emails to BayRICS to obtain their leaving office date. However, we have not yet received a response regarding those inquiries.

Since we are unable to obtain the individual's leaving office date and it does not appear that the SEI Unit has notified the individual of their Leaving Office SEI filing requirements, we are closing the above-referenced matter with no further action. Please determine the leaving office date and notify Christopher Collins of the requirement to file a Leaving Office SEI. If they do not comply in response to the SEI Unit's requests to file a Leaving Office SEI, please re-refer the matter to the Enforcement Division.
