The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”). This letter is in response to a sworn complaint alleging that the committee, Lynwood Families For Progress (the “Committee”), failed to timely file campaign statements reporting certain pre-election activity.

The Enforcement Division has completed its review of the matter and determined that the Committee met their filing obligations in advance of the June 7, 2022 Primary Election. Therefore, the allegations have been disproven, and we are closing this matter without further action.
